Instrument Storage

Mr. Matherly and I are making efforts to make sure all student and school instruments are secure during the school day. Please advise your children to take their instruments into the band hall storage room once they have arrived at school. The hallway that leads to the band room is a very public walking space and is in no way secure. Our band hall is not occupied by students unless one of the directors is present; therefore this is the safest place for the instruments while the students are on campus. The band hall will be open at 7:20a.m. each morning. If your child has obligations that do not allow them to bring the instrument into the band hall after 7:20a.m., they will need to have another band student take their instrument into the storage room. Also, to assist in this effort it is also advised that each student have a name tag attached to their instrument and each parent have a copy of the serial number written down at home for reference (even if it is a school instrument that is checked out to them).

Students leaving their instruments out in the hallway or other parts of the school are subject to lunch detention assignment.

Thank you for your assistance in this effort; it is imperative that we keep these instruments in the best of care.
